- Reviewing and approving international shipments, foreign travel, incoming foreign visitors, release of technical data and technology, to ensure compliance with applicable U.S. and foreign regulations and Harris policies and procedures.
- Providing ad hoc export training.
- Assisting with internal audits.
- Reporting violations to the SAS Empowered Official.
- Drafting voluntary self-disclosures as needed.
- Developing, implementing, and tracking corrective actions
